AMMAN - Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Knowledge Center (TAG-KC), a member of Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global (TAG.Global), held various training courses in March 2022, conducted digitally and face-to-face, including the following:

## 'Abu-Ghazaleh Global' Concludes Cybersecurity Workshop for Public Security Staff



AMMAN – Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global (TAG.Global) concluded a workshop organized in cooperation with the UAE-based Black Mountain Cybersecurity Company for members of various security departments at the Public Security Directorate on Cybersecurity.

The training workshop was organized as part of the cooperation and support provided by TAG.Global to the Jordanian security directorate, where it was organized in collaboration between Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Knowledge Forum (TAG-KF) and Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Knowledge Center (TAG-KC).

The 4-day workshop was held with 6-hour training a day, attended by 100 public security officers from various ranks.

## Activities of TAG-Knowledge Stations in March 2022



The Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Knowledge Stations, spread throughout the Kingdom's governorates, implemented various activities in March 2022. The most significant of them are:

1. Signing a cooperation agreement between TAG-KC and Hareer (Silk) Initiative for Social Development to cooperate in organizing and holding training courses in the community service area.
